About Us

The roots of Scottish Disability Equality Forum (SDEF) go back to a conference held in Erskine in 1995 on 'The Empowerment of Disabled People'.



Over the next eight years, the Disability Forum which resulted from these efforts worked towards achieving a mandate to see a Scottish Forum established.

In 2003, we were founded with the aim of reducing barriers to disability equality, promoting awareness of good practice in accessibility and inclusion across Scotland.

We are the umbrella organisation for Access Panels across Scotland. We work with Panels to support and help them to provide advice and support to disabled people in the local communities.

Today, we are involved across a wide range of work, ensuring that the many voices of disabled people are heard and heeded to on a local and national level. We work to bring real change to the lives of disabled people, to inspire and to motivate others to be inclusive and informed in their attitude towards disabled people, and to bring the message of equality for all.
